



Notification of Office of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission

Re: No Gift Policy

In accordance with the Cabinet resolution on national reform plan in preventing and suppressing the corruption and misconduct (amended), Activity no. 4: Improvement of Thai Government Bureaucracy System with transparency and without benefits; Objective no. 10 (1.1) states that:

“all government agencies to declare that their officials do not accept gifts or other forms of benefits while performing official duties (No Gift Policy)”.

In order to promote Office of the NBTC culture and integrity values to perform duties with moral, ethics, transparency, preventing unfair action, opposing all types of bribery, and preventing conflict of interest, Office of the NBTC, hereby, declares that all Office of the NBTC’s personnel must strictly adhere as follows:

1. Must not accept gifts or all types of benefits during/before/after performing duties that could result in corruption and misconduct.
2. Must not provide gifts or all types of benefits while performing duties.
3. Must not perform or refrain from obtaining gifts, benefits, assets, or other types of rewards unlawfully.
4. In order to receive assets or benefits ethically, it should follow the Notification of Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission regarding the criteria for receiving property or other benefits ethically according to the ethics of the state civil service department.
