Voice TV blackout 'unlawful'

MEDIA: The National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission's (NBTC) 15-day "gag order" for Voice TV is unlawful, the Central Administrative Court ruled yesterday.

The court found no argument to support the NBTC's claims that two of Voice TV's programmes contained misleading and potentially seditious content, the ruling said.

The NBTC also failed to give Voice TV a chance to counter the accusations made against it, the court said.

In addition, the court also issued an injunction against NBTC's black-out order that allows Voice TV to broadcast its programmes, pending a trial.
