



**Announcement of the Office of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission
Regarding Revocation of Announcement of Recruitment and Selection of Visiting Fellows
(Visiting Fellows with Expertise in the Field of Media and Communications,
particularly Mass Media, Media Innovation, Media Entrepreneurship
