



## **Announcement of the Office of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission Regarding recruitment and selection of Visiting Fellow**

---

The Office of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission aims to select qualified external candidates to serve as Visiting Fellows. These individuals will be responsible for acquiring valuable insights, conducting research, and providing expert opinions on academic, legal, and other related topics that will be beneficial to the NBTC's missions.

The Office of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission therefore announced the recruitment of external candidates to be appointed as Visiting Fellows. The details are as follows:

1. Specific research expertise to be selected
  - Visiting Fellows with expertise in the field of economics, particularly industrial organization and public policy, and quantitative economics.

2. General qualifications and prohibited characteristics of the Visiting Fellows to be selected.

A Visiting Fellow must have general qualifications and not be under any of the prohibitions as follows:

- (1) expertise in the field of research, with proven records or work achievements demonstrating knowledge, competence, and integrity;
- (2) not being a current officer or employee of Office of the NBTC;
- (3) not holding any position that has conflicts of interest against the performance of duties either directly or indirectly.

In the case of being an officer, an employee or a wage-earner of government agencies, State enterprises or State agencies or other State officials, the individual must obtain permission from the original affiliation. The period of duty at Office of the NBTC shall be clearly specified.

3. Specific qualifications of the Visiting Fellows to be selected

Applicants who apply to the Visiting Fellows in Economics Research must have specific qualifications as follows:

- (1) being a highly qualified academician or expert within the country or abroad; from a university, government organization or private sector and must have completed at least a master's degree or other equivalent qualifications at the same level, as certified by The Civil Service Commission (CSC). The degree must be in the field of industrial organization economics, theoretical economics, quantitative economics, or other related areas, in compliance with the criteria and conditions specified by the Office of the NBTC

(2) having relevant experience or research related to the market definition in broadcasting or telecommunications

#### 4. Application

(1) applicants must have the qualifications as specified in 2. and 3. and submit supporting documents through the registration system: [Visitingfellow.nbtc.go.th](http://Visitingfellow.nbtc.go.th) between 19 April 2023 and 3 May 2023

##### (2) application documents

1) applicant's curriculum vitae (CV) with a photograph, supporting documents demonstrating educational qualifications, knowledge, abilities, duration of work experience and any specific qualifications relevant to the duties and responsibilities associated with the nature of work to be performed

2) research concepts and methods for formulating the market definition in broadcasting or telecommunications

3) academic work in the field of research relevant to the responsibilities and nature of work. The scholarly work should have been published or made available to the general public.

#### 5. Conditions for Admission

Applicants are required to verify and certify the validity of their qualifications for the positions they are applying for. In the event that any errors caused by the applicants are found or if the documentary evidence is inaccurate or incomplete, the applicants will be disqualified from further consideration, in accordance with this announcement.

The Office of the NBTC reserves the right to consider recruiting only those candidates who have submitted correct and complete documents as specified only. The Selection Committee has the right to request additional supporting documents for consideration.

#### 6. Criteria and selection methods

##### (1) inspection of qualifications

The Selection Committee will examine and verify the qualifications of applicants based on the documents submitted through the application portal. After the completion of the verification process, the list of qualified candidates who are eligible for selection will be announced via the Office of the NBTC's website ([www.nbtc.go.th](http://www.nbtc.go.th)) on 12 May 2023.

##### (2) selection

The Selection Committee will consider the list of applicants who are fully qualified under (1) by proceeding as follows:

1) evaluation of experiences and academic works based on the submitted evidence

2) other criteria as the Selection Committee deems appropriate, in which the Office of the NBTC will notify applicants accordingly.

3) Applicants will be evaluated for their competency and suitability through an interview process. The evaluation criteria will be based on a point system, with 40 percent of the score for supporting documents, 40 percent for academic works and research experience, and 20 percent for the interview. Applicants must receive an overall score of at least 80 percent to be considered for selection.

4) The Selection Committee is responsible for nominating the chosen candidates for the Visiting Fellows position. These candidates will then be considered and approved by the NBTC before the final selection is announced.

#### 7. Announcement of the list of selected candidates

The Office of the NBTC will announce the list of selected candidates who have been approved by the NBTC via the Office of the NBTC's website ( [www.nbtc.go.th](http://www.nbtc.go.th)).

#### 8. Appointment

The Office of the NBTC will issue an appointment order for the selected candidates approved by the NBTC, to serve as Visiting Fellows in their respective areas of research. The term of duty is determined by the agreement between the Office of the NBTC and the appointed Visiting Fellow. Depending on the appointment period and the research topic, each period should not exceed one year or the duration of the fiscal year, in accordance with the Regulation of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission on the Appointment of Visiting Fellows B.E. 2565 (2022)
