

Waivers

Each bidder is allowed a maximum of three waivers during the auction. However, in the first round of the auction the bidder cannot use the waiver and must place bid for a spectrum lot. In the second and subsequent rounds, the bidder who is the provisional winner is not allowed to use the waiver.

In the second and subsequent rounds, the bidder who is not the provisional winner and still has waivers left can use a waiver by two means as follows:

- 1) The bidder requests to use a waiver; or
- 2) The bidder does not place any bid during the bidding stage, the waiver will be used automatically.

In the case that the bidder is not the provisional winner and still has waivers, the bidder can choose not to use the waiver. Such bidder will no longer have the right to place bid or use the waiver in the subsequent rounds.
